We are currently choosing our next class treat and are working very hard to earn all of our class rewards. Our class topic this term is Robot Rampage. Some of us have made our own models of robots at home and have brought them into school - they look amazing!

Tawny Owls topic this term is called Robot Rampage. We will be looking at how technology have improved over the years and how it has a big impact on our lives today. We will also be looking at the role robots play in our lives and will be working towards a design and technology project where we will be making out own robots with moving parts and parts that light up. Our science focus will be electricity, we have begun to look at how we use electricity and will be moving onto circuits. We will be learning how to make a circuit with light bulbs, buzzers and motors. These circuits will then be used in our robots.
