Parent Questionnaire Responses

- The group looked at the responses to the parent questionnaires completed at Parent/Teacher Consultation in April 2019
- Overall the responses were positive
- The group considered the two responses with the most disagree and strongly disagree responses
 - **I believe pupils behave well in school** – Strongly agree 29.7%, Agree 52.3%, Disagree 13.3%, Strongly Disagree 0.8%, Don't Know 2.3% and Blank 1.6%
 - **Other children do not bully my child** - Strongly agree 30.5%, Agree 46.1%, Disagree 13.3%, Strongly Disagree 6.3%, Don't Know 0.8% and Blank 3.1%
- Parents felt there was perhaps a lack of understanding about the term 'bullying' both with pupils and parents

7	School to ensure events are shared in good time and across all communication channels	STAFF
8	School to run an information session to share the purpose of the school's nurture provision and how it is accessed	CW/CE
